## INTRAMURAL PERMISSION SLIP FOR CROSS-COUNTRY, SOCCER, & BASKETBALL INTRAMURALS BEGIN TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 20<sup>TH</sup>

Your child wishes to participate in the TOR Intramural Program. The program begins at 2:55 p.m. and ends at 3:55 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday (see specific schedule for Soccer/Basketball days). In the fall season we are offering a **Cross-Country Team**, **Intramural Soccer**, and Intramural Basketball

**SOCCER:** The Soccer Intramurals participants do not travel, they only play at TOR. You may pick up your child in the front of the school at 4:00. Turn of River Middle School has a late bus for students at 4:00 p.m. The late bus does not drop your child off at the same spot as their regular bus; it will drop them off in the same vicinity.

**Basketball:** The Basketball Intramurals participants do not travel, they only play at TOR. You may pick up your child in the front of the school at 4:00. <u>CROSS-COUNTRY</u> is a team commitment and your child must be in attendance for practices every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday as well as the meets. Students will be transported to the away meet by a school bus. After the meet there will be a late bus for them to take home or you are welcome to pick your child up at the meet. There is no transportation back to TOR. Pick-up after practices will be in the front circle or your student is welcome to take the late bus home. The late bus does not drop your child off at the same spot as their regular bus; it will drop them off in the same vicinity. (\*Meet dates 10/6, 10/11, 10/18, & 11/1 – More information to follow)

**IMPORTANT HEALTH REMINDER:** If your child is participating in the after school intramural athletic program and they need the use of their inhaler, epi-pen, or other medication you need to provide the Athletic Department with the medication necessary should an emergency arise. The state requirement is that medications for interscholastic and intramural are separate from the medications that are used during the school day. Please have your child bring in all necessary medication as soon as possible unopened, labeled, and in a Ziploc bag. Safety is our first priority when it comes to your child's needs.
